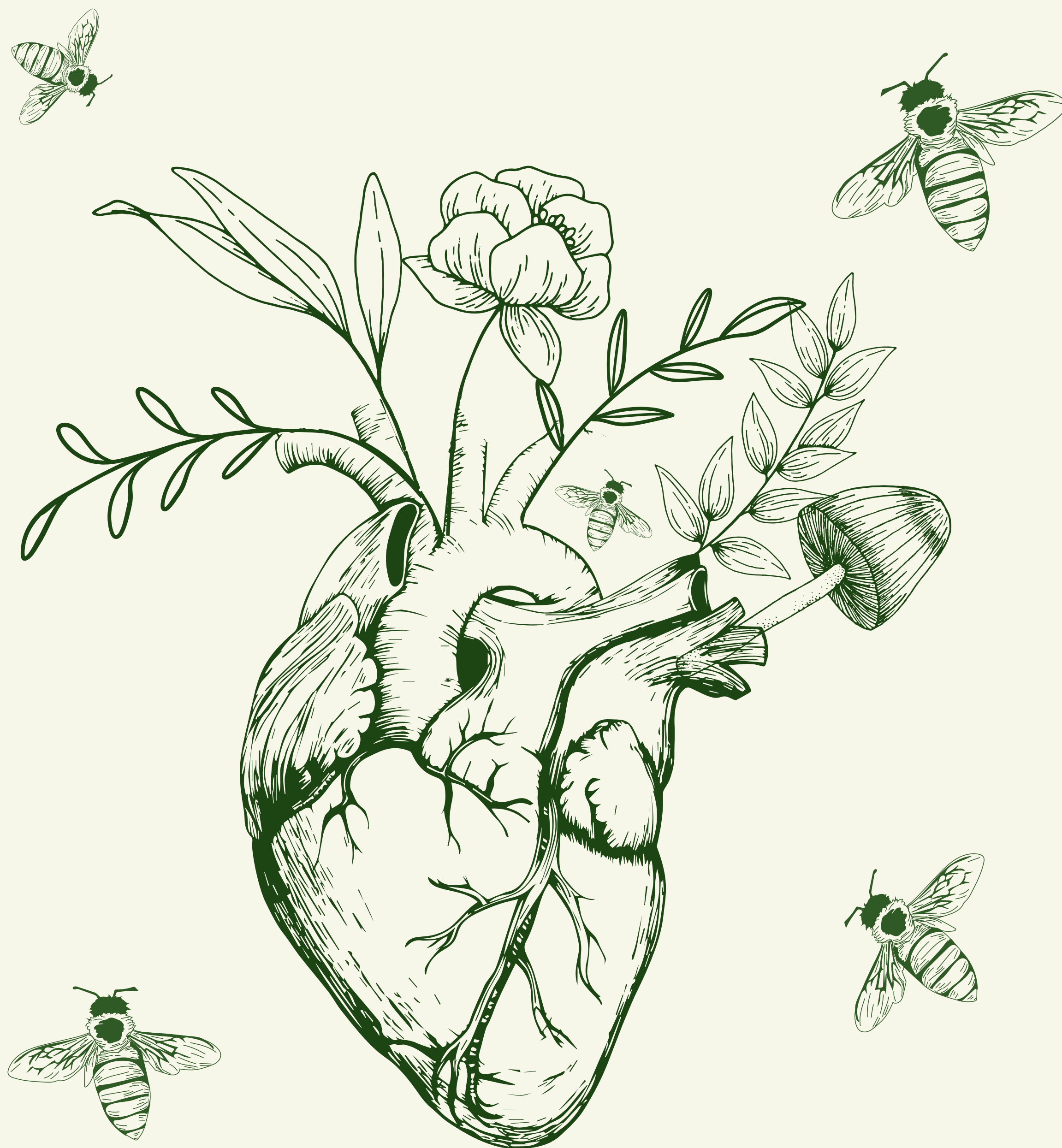

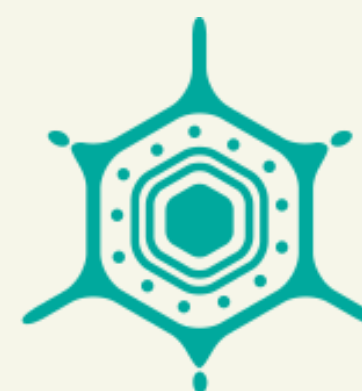

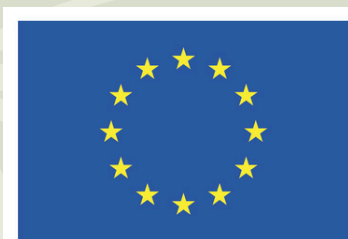
Welcome!

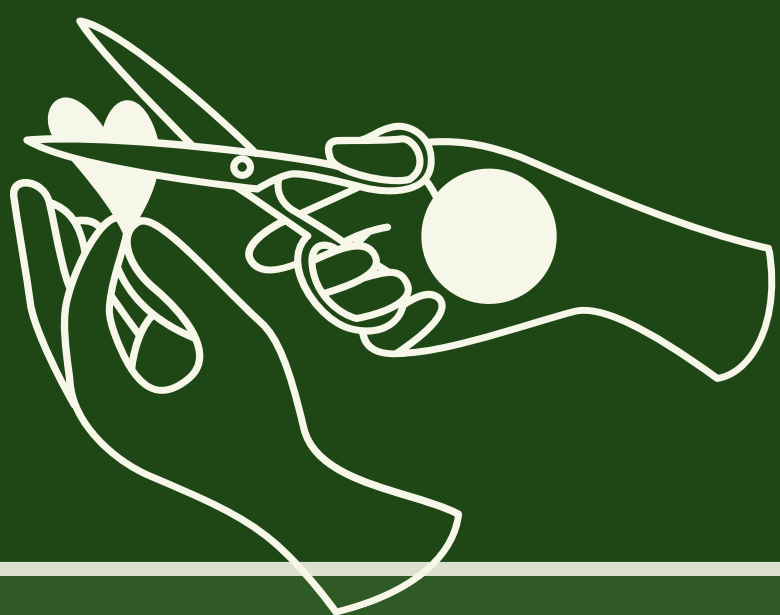
What Will We Do?

Each national group will have a supportive youth leader

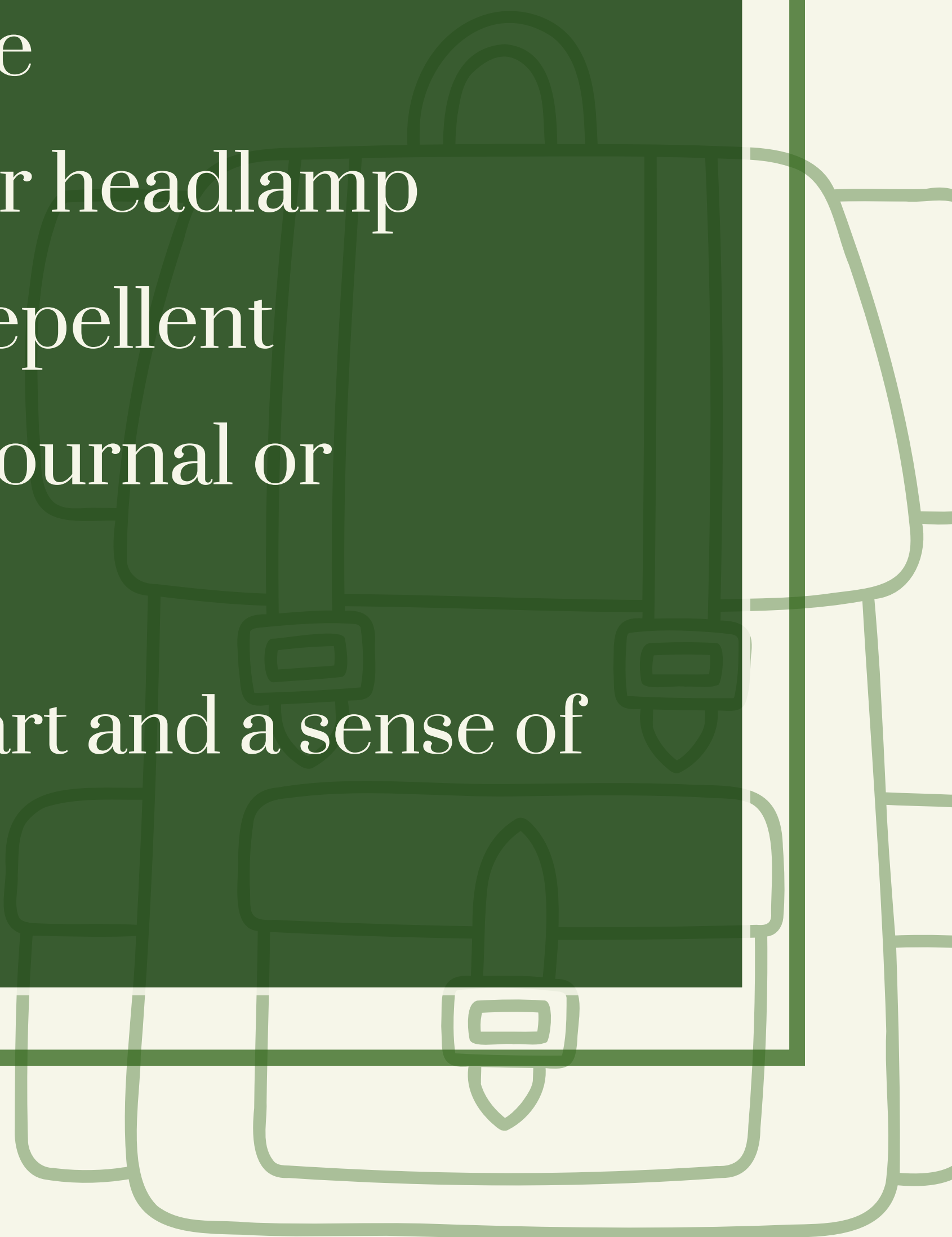

Important Notes

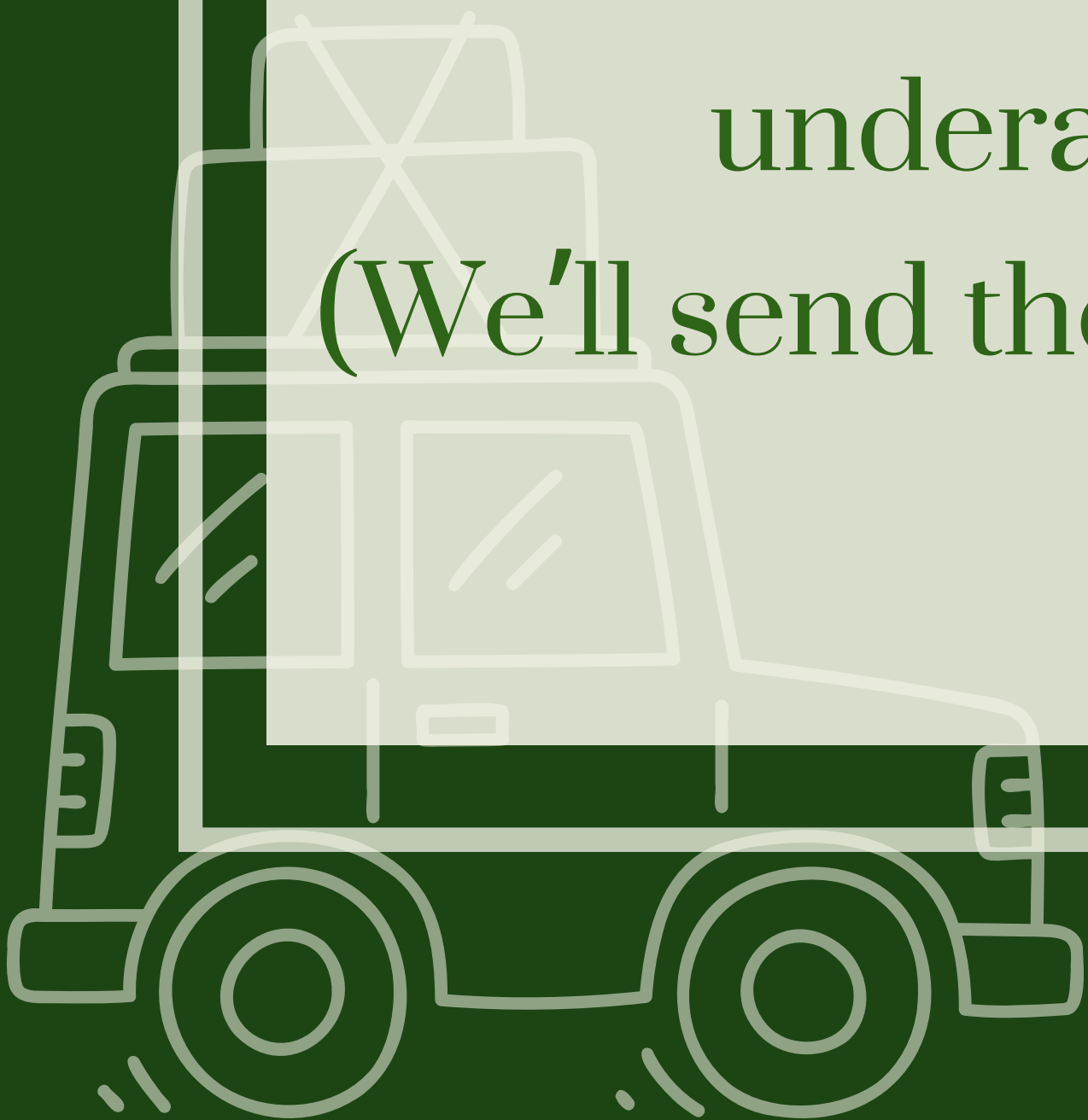
The project covers accommodation, activities, trainers, and food.

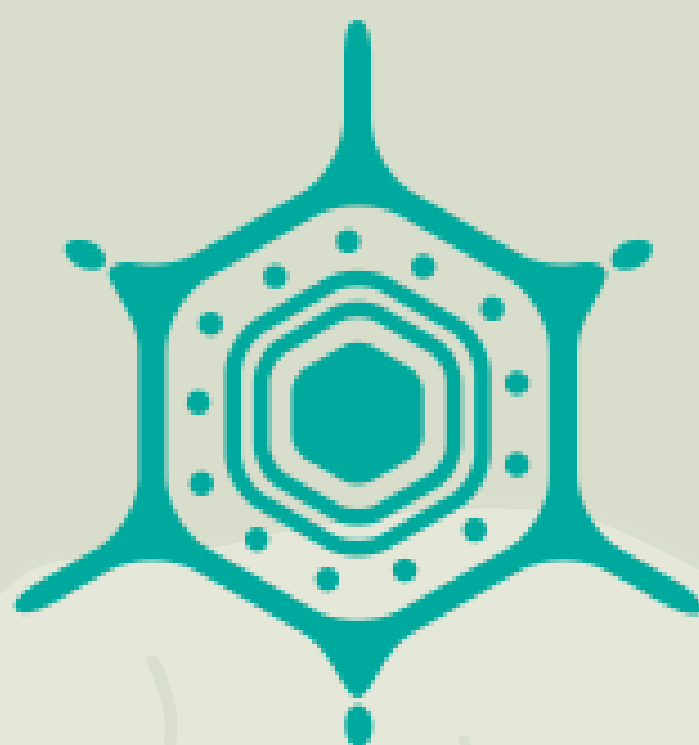

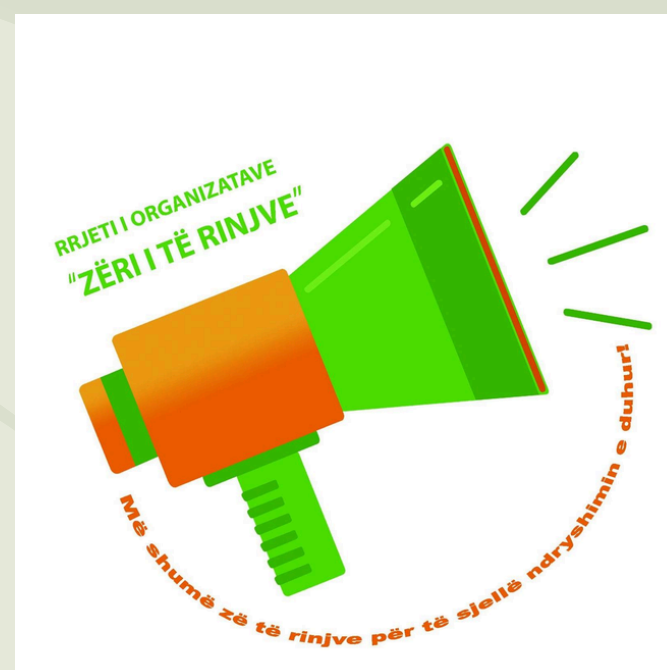
